

BOARD MEETINGS 1982 <sup>New Secretary</sup> 10/06/82

The 1983 first quarterly meeting of the Church Pine, Round and Big Lake Protection and Rehabilitation district was held at the home of Dick Larson on Oct 6 - 1982 at 7:30 p.m. Our meeting was called to order by our chairman, Dick Larson, with all board members present.

The secretary's minutes were read and approved. Our treasurer, Dick Bergquist, handed out a written report. The C.D.<sup>s</sup> which matured on Oct 1, 1982, was transferred to a passbook savings account at 5.5%. Another C.D. may be considered again at a later date. The present account balance is \$5,879.25.

Dick Larson handed out a leaflet on Composting toilets and how they work. People who are planning to install a new septic system, or are currently having problems with their present system may find this leaflet helpful.

A suggestion by Dick Larson was made to have our mailing list be brought up to date. This could be accomplished by contacting the Chairman or Treasurer of each township for names and addresses of property owners on the lakes.

Discussion was held on the subject of water skiing. It was suggested each property owner be mailed a letter stating the regulations

Dick Larson is planning to call the Department of Natural resources on the wetland preservation around the three lakes.

Dick Bergquist suggested the culvert between Big Lake and Round Lake be drenched out. This would make it easier for boats to go through.

The question of the sewers and septic systems on the lakes was brought up by Dick Larson. a suggestion by Dick was made that we ask each property owner to check their system by usage of pills.

Dick Bergquist asked about having the lakes stocked with walleyes. No information was available at this time. Dick Larson was going to ask Elden Kern if he would be interested in the job of fish management on our three lakes.

The secretary was asked to send a copy of the minutes to each of the officers.

Motion <sup>was</sup> made by Sea King second by Dick Bergquist to adjourn.

was read by the chairman and a motion was  
made by him to pay the membership fee of  
\$100.<sup>00</sup>. The motion was seconded by Dick  
Bergquist.

Dick Larson made a motion that a gift  
certificate for \$25.<sup>00</sup> be presented to the  
Secretary for the years of service to the  
organization. Seconded by Dick Bergquist.

The annual meeting was tentatively set up  
for Aug. 7<sup>th</sup> pending approval of West Inman  
Church for a meeting place.

Cake & coffee served by secretary, who also
