MEETING MINUTES - MAY 1995

Big, Round and Church Pine Lakes Weed Control (Water Quality) Committee met 10:00 AM, May 6, 1995, at Dick Rudolph's place. Members present included: Tom Diaz, John Schulte, Ann Moberg, Dick Rudolph, and Ron Skone.

Items discussed and acted upon:

1. Identification of common area for herbicide treatment on Round and Church Pine Lakes.
  - a. Channel connecting the two lakes - 30' wide and 200' long (100' each direction from center point).
  - b. Beyond channel into Church Pine Lake - 200' wide by 300' long area on west side of lake starting beyond the lily pads.
  - c. Big Lake and channel area into Round Lake previously identified.

Dick Rudolph will locate all areas on lake maps along with a narrative description and provide to Lake Restoration who will in turn coordinate with Dick on first weed control application date. Dick will notify other board members who will assist in marking of the area with Lake Restoration.

2. Dick will contact Dick Berquisit to get the name of the land owner whose land cut weeds were dumped on last year and secure approval for this year's weeds.
3. John Schulte volunteered to check with Blue Water Science in St. Paul regarding the testing of water samples. We identified sample collection areas in North Creek and SE inlet as follows:
  - a. Mouth of North Creek
  - b. Bridge NE of mouth
  - c. Railroad bridge
  - d. South of Mork's farm, east of driveway next to house south of creek.
  - e. Inlet by Mork's Store.

Ron will also check with Fred Homan to see if he has any water sample equipment in his possession from prior years. Should neither of the above two approaches work out to collect water samples and have them tested, we agreed to use Lake Restoration to conduct water quality testing. Dick will make inquiries of them on this subject.

4. Discussed booklet, "A Model Lake Plan for a Local Community". Need to address options 3, 4, 6, 11 and 12 when we develop a lake plan to improve our water quality.
5. John Schulte and Dick Rudolph will jointly work on a Grant Application in support of our lake plan that needs to be submitted to the Wisconsin DNR.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> quarterly meeting of 1994/1995 was held Jan. 7, 1995 in New Richmond at Dick Bergquist's office. In attendance were Dick Rudolph, John Schuele, Ruben Johnson, Ed Bruere, Dick Bergquist, Kathy Videw.

Dick Rudolph reported on vegetation control. The committee met 4 times. They requested bids for cutting & herbicide. Wayne Lindberg, Midwest Aquatic Care didn't respond. Lake Restoration did. Each owner would contract for individual cutting. The lake district would pay for common areas. The committee is meeting with DNR to discuss treatment for Churchpin & Round Jan 9. ~~Now~~ The committee has decided they would like to send a letter, with board approval, that the weed cutter will be contacting them. MM Mark, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dick B, to approve. MM Ed, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dick to place \$4000 limit on removal. MM Mark, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dick to give weed committee authority to test water quality at both ~~Churchpin~~ inlets for a maximum amount of \$2000. The committee recommends we use Lake Restoration. The board unanimously concurred, and lets the 1995 bid to Lake Restoration.

Dick B. recommends by state law, we should have 3 property owners audit our books once a year. The chairman should appoint them and report to the annual meeting.

Dick B. wants someone from Churchpin

to replace him at the end of his term.  
Next meeting, end of April.
