

GENERAL MEETINGS 1982 08/07/82

Aug. 7, 1982

The annual meeting of the Church Pine, Round & Big Lakes was held on Saturday, Aug. 7, 1982 at 1:20 P.M. in the West Immanuel Lutheran Church Hall.

The meeting was called to order at 1:35 by the chairman, Dick Larson. Introduction of the officers and guest speakers was made. The minutes of the last annual meeting and a summary of the four board meetings were read and approved.

The treasurer's report was given showing a balance of \$78.71 in checking, \$733.10 in savings and \$4500⁰⁰ in certificates. Interest to date on savings is \$26.34 and \$567.45 interest is due Oct. 1 on the certificates.

A letter was read from Rick Cornelius to the fish chairman on the stocking of northern in 1982 in the Big Lake marsh.

The chairman reported no further progress on the Step One procedure by Mateffy Engineering because of a cut on federal financing. Also reported on algae, swimmer's itch, spraying results & rip rap violations and the D.N.R. wants a permit issued for shore improvement. It also was reported that a weed cutting unit was purchased and recommended for

individuals to purchase

Discussed wetlands preservation.

The subject of security of cabins & breakins was brought up and Deputy Sheriff Bob Moore was introduced. He stated that because of a shortage of manpower in his department we should be more alert as neighbors and keep an eye on each others property and do not report any violations unless you are prepared to give your name to the police. We should also place identification marks on our property & list serial numbers. He also discussed the after hour violations and beer consumption on the Church Pine road & on the access.

Bob Swanda was introduced who spoke on alarm systems and protection devices.

Warden Jerry Wagner was introduced and spoke on water safety and lake and boat violations. He also informed us he is only allowed to enforce State Laws. A question and answer period followed.

Under old business, the water skiing ordinance was brought up again. After much discussion, a motion was made by Frank Weinecke to leave the ordinance as written but to add to it the wording "all

towed craft." It was seconded by Nick Tedesco.
A motion was made by Stuart Utgaard
and seconded by Mr. Heber that we
prohibit fishing before ten A.M. and
after 7 P.M. The motion was defeated.

Under new business, someone asked who had
the cleanup responsibility at the lake
accesses and it was reported that Buzz
Pensel was currently taking care of it
but it will be discussed further at a
future Board meeting.

A new officer was to be voted on to replace
the secretary position. Caroline Larson
nominated Ben Hinz. Bill Berke seconded.
John Scanlon made a motion the nominations
be closed. Lionel Forrest seconded.
