Annual Mtg. 9/1/90

The 13<sup>th</sup> Annual meeting of the Churchpine, Round, and Big Lake Protection & Rehabilitation District was held Sat., Sept 1, 1990 at 10 AM at Immanuel Lutheran Church. Chairman Dick Bequist opened the meeting with an agenda.

Secretary's report was read. Motion made by Chuck Fuelmer, seconded by Bob Law to accept. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report was given by Fred Homan. Balance as of 8-7-89 \$4587.45. Total receipts including interest of \$14,761.88 gave total of \$19,349.33. Disbursements of \$7,935.32 leaves balance of \$11,414.01. M made by Bob Law, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Chuck Fuelmer to accept. M carried.

Don Tahne reported on weedcutting. Aquacare has offered to sell us their machines. Prices: \$24,000 6ft., \$32,000 7ft., \$5,000 for the elevator. A new 5ft. machine costs \$40,000. (Allowance for @ \$2000 insurance for men & machines, & \$200 for storage would need to be made. We could lease a truck, & cut at our convenience).

This year there were complaints. Questions & answers from floor & answers:

① What is cost to have shoreline contracted?

② \$75 to cut 100' shoreline

③ What weed is in Big Lake?

④ This year it's floating coontail - it has no roots & is not weedcutting leftovers.

⑤ Why wasn't east shore Pine Lake cut?

⑥ Discussion of how we pay for weed cutting on taxes. Comments from many were in favor of cutting common areas & each individual contract out for the lakeshore.

⑧ What is the long term effect of weed cutting?

@ when you cut, you are removing some nutrients that feed the lake.

It was a very wet spring. Dick Lawson commented that paying for weed cutting on taxes is tax-deductible.

Curtis Paulson made M, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bob Jew to cut channels & landings only, & board to arrange with AquaCare for individual contracting. 35 yd, 42 ray, motion failed.

M made Sue Dennison, 2<sup>nd</sup> Dick Lawson to increase weed cutting budget to \$8000, one cutting, & call for volunteer assistance to monitor the weed cutting. Motion carried

Keith Lindstrom reported for the water patrol. Dory Hogan was also present. DNR updates:

① You do not need a PFD to operate a sailboard

② 100' within dock, raft, & where marked = sk no wake

③ if a craft is kept within a 60 consecutive days, it must be registered. A sailboat over 12' must be registered, otherwise non-motorized, need not be registered.



- ④ Skier or knee boarder doesn't need to wear a PFD, but there must be one for them in the boat
- ⑤ 16 watercraft needs 1 ea. wearable & 1 throwable
- ⑥ Check your pfd's - if you can squeeze it, throw it - you'll drown
- ⑦ When a watercraft is in motion, all persons must be inside
- ⑧ Water safety classes in conjunction with DNR are open to anyone 10+ years, age 12-16 + boating safety to operate a boat alone.

Dick Berquist noted that Larry Damon transferred to State Fisheries - Cumberland. is in a quagmire. Dredging between Churchville and Round would be an 8-10,000 job.

The budget <sup>needs</sup> for 1991 ~~was~~ <sup>will</sup> be estimated as follows:

- \$8000 weed cutting
- \$3000 water patrol
- \$1100 misc expenses
- \$12,100 total

Current balance is \$7000. We need to leave some cushion for dam problems.

MM Dick Lawson, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Mrs Jahnke to levy \$10,000. Motion carried.

Ballot for election of officers was determined. Don Jahnke (from Round Lake) & Fred Tomaris (from Big Lake) terms are expired. Nominations to fill the terms will later:
